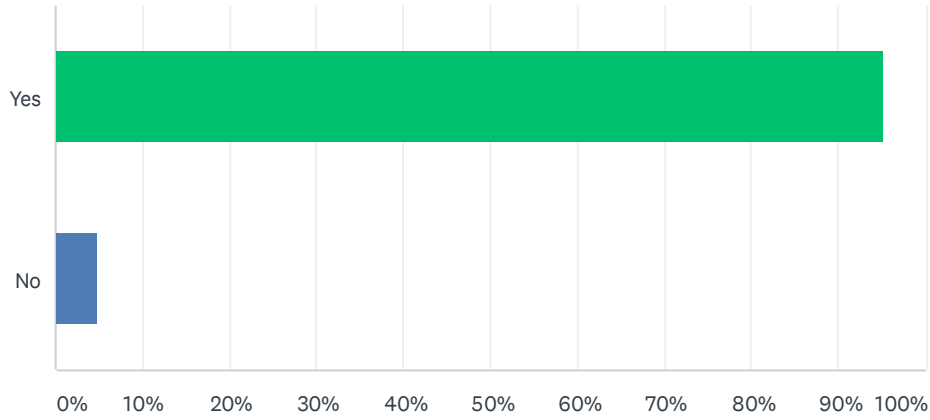


Q1 Do you plan to return for Spring 2022 Semester classes?

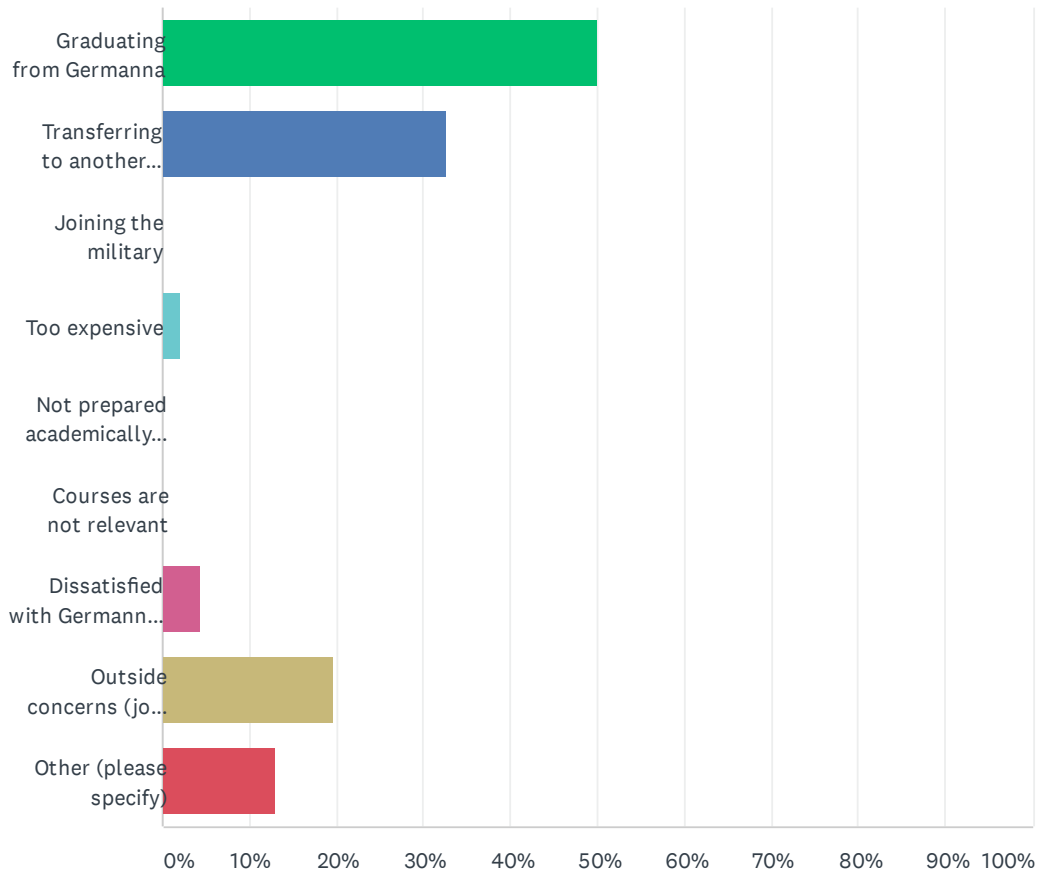

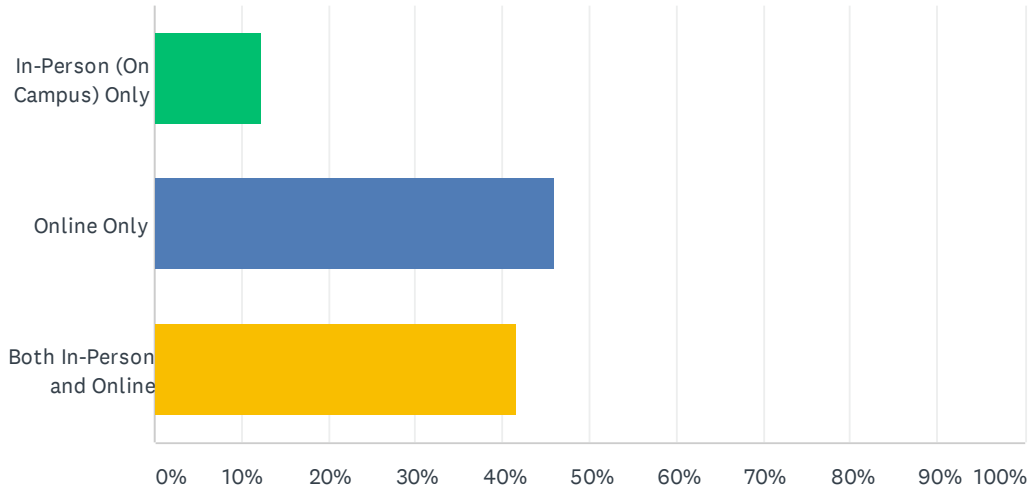

Q3 How would you prefer to take your classes this spring?

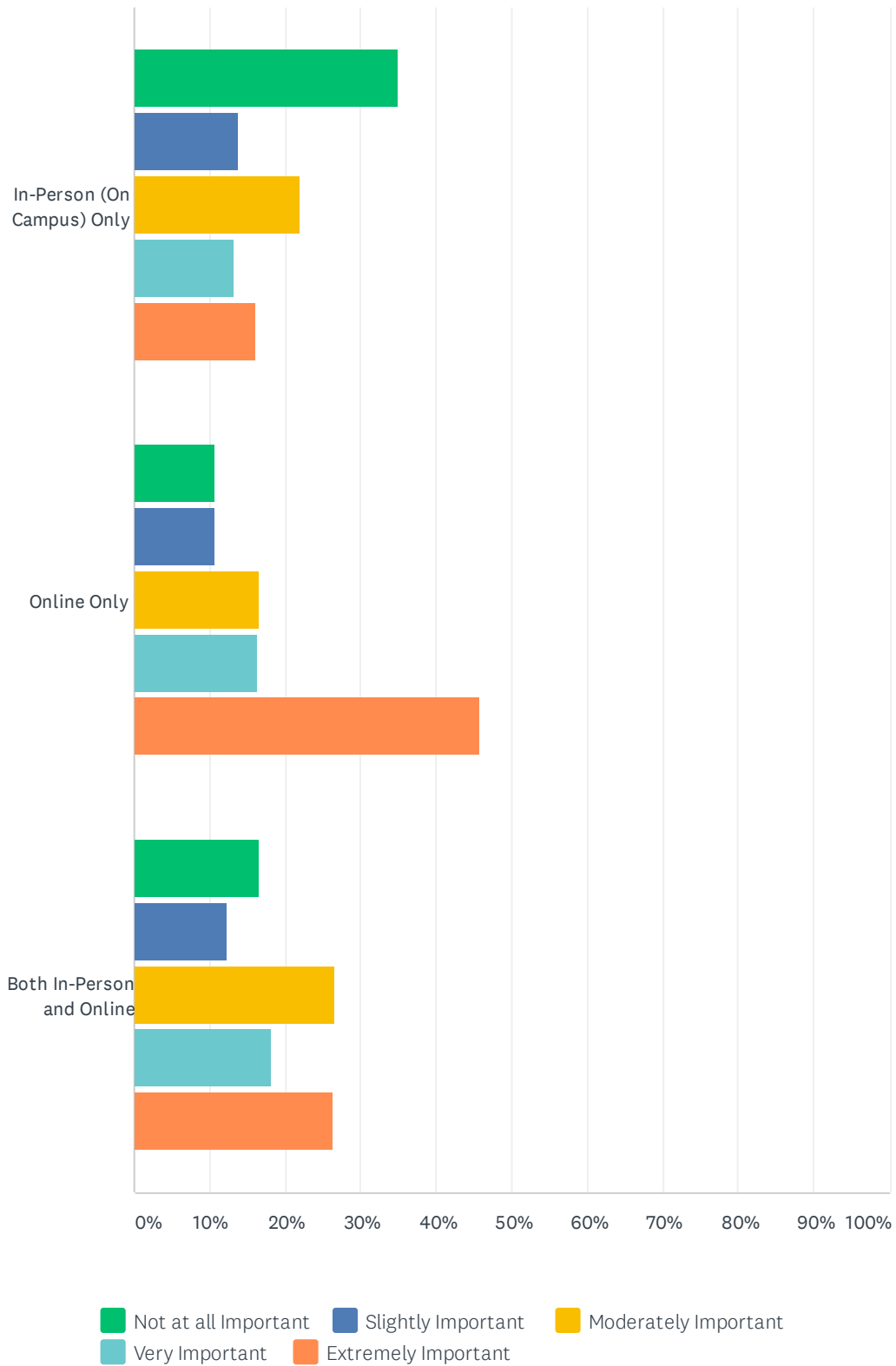

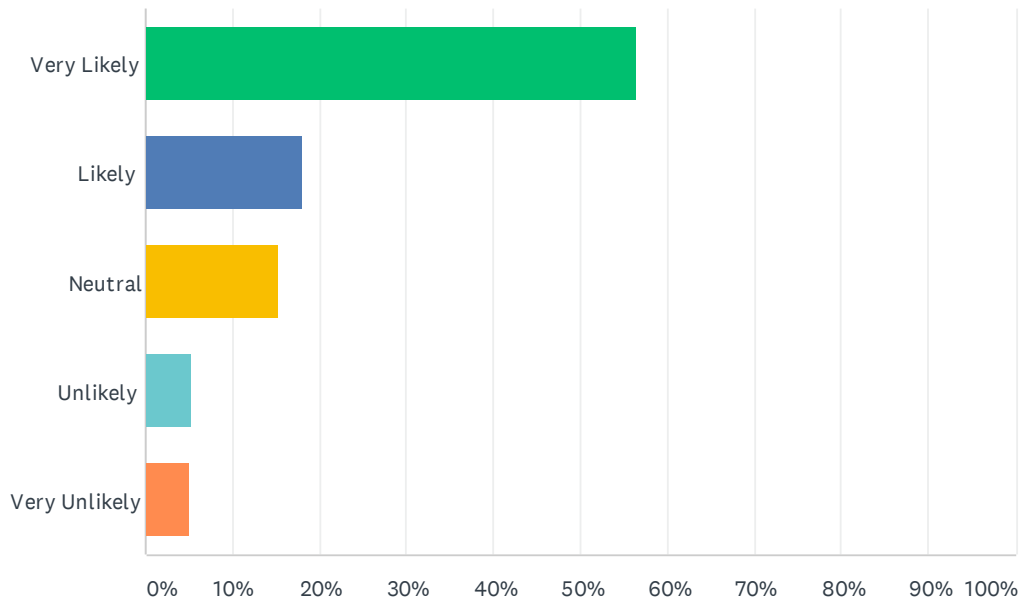

Q5 If Germanna did not offer in-person classes and services in the Spring, how likely would you be to return to Germanna?

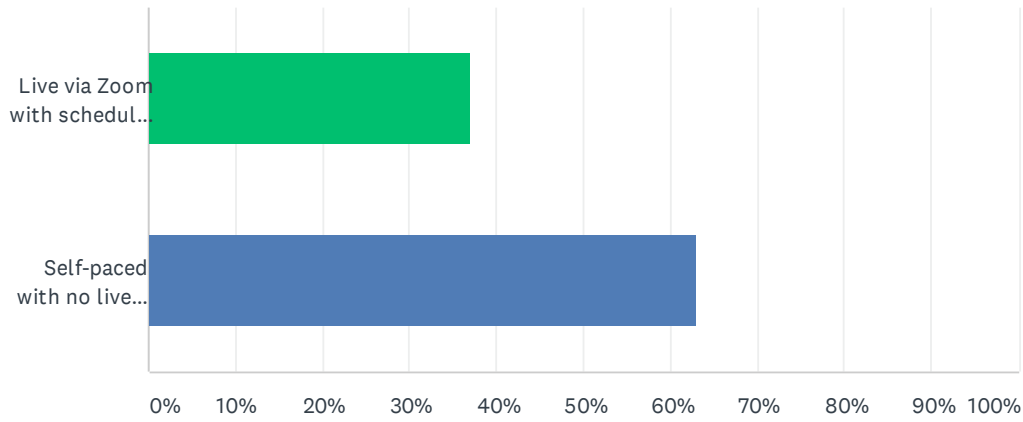

Q6 What is your preference for online course delivery?

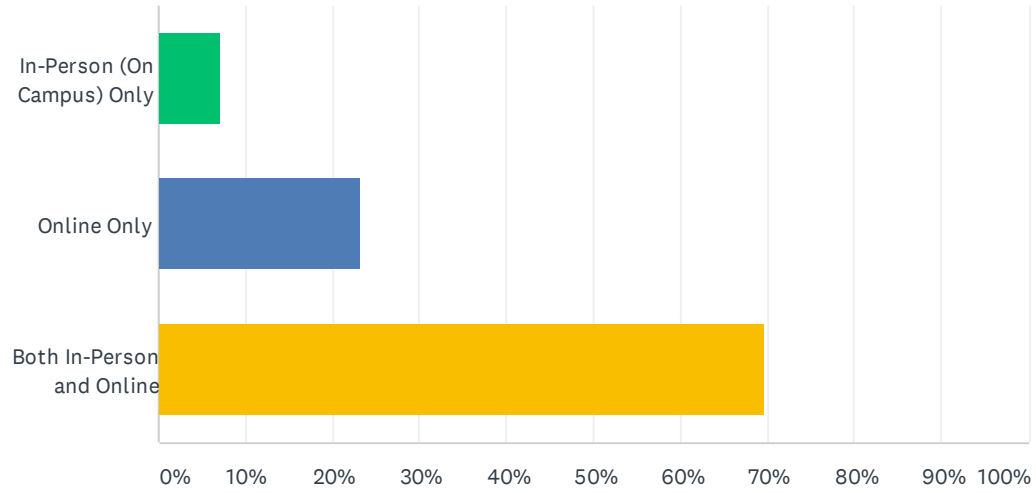

Q7 How would you prefer student services be delivered?

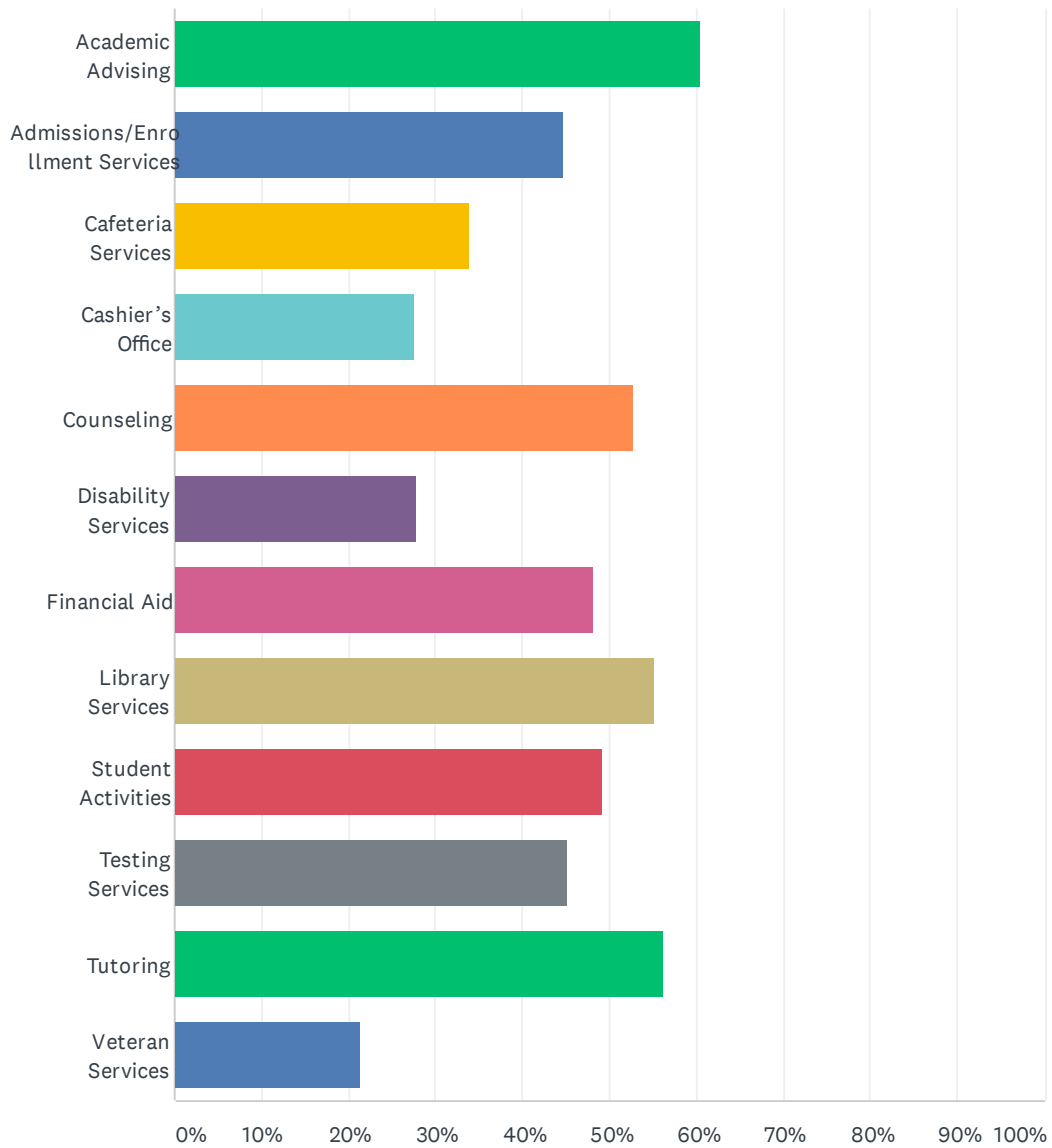

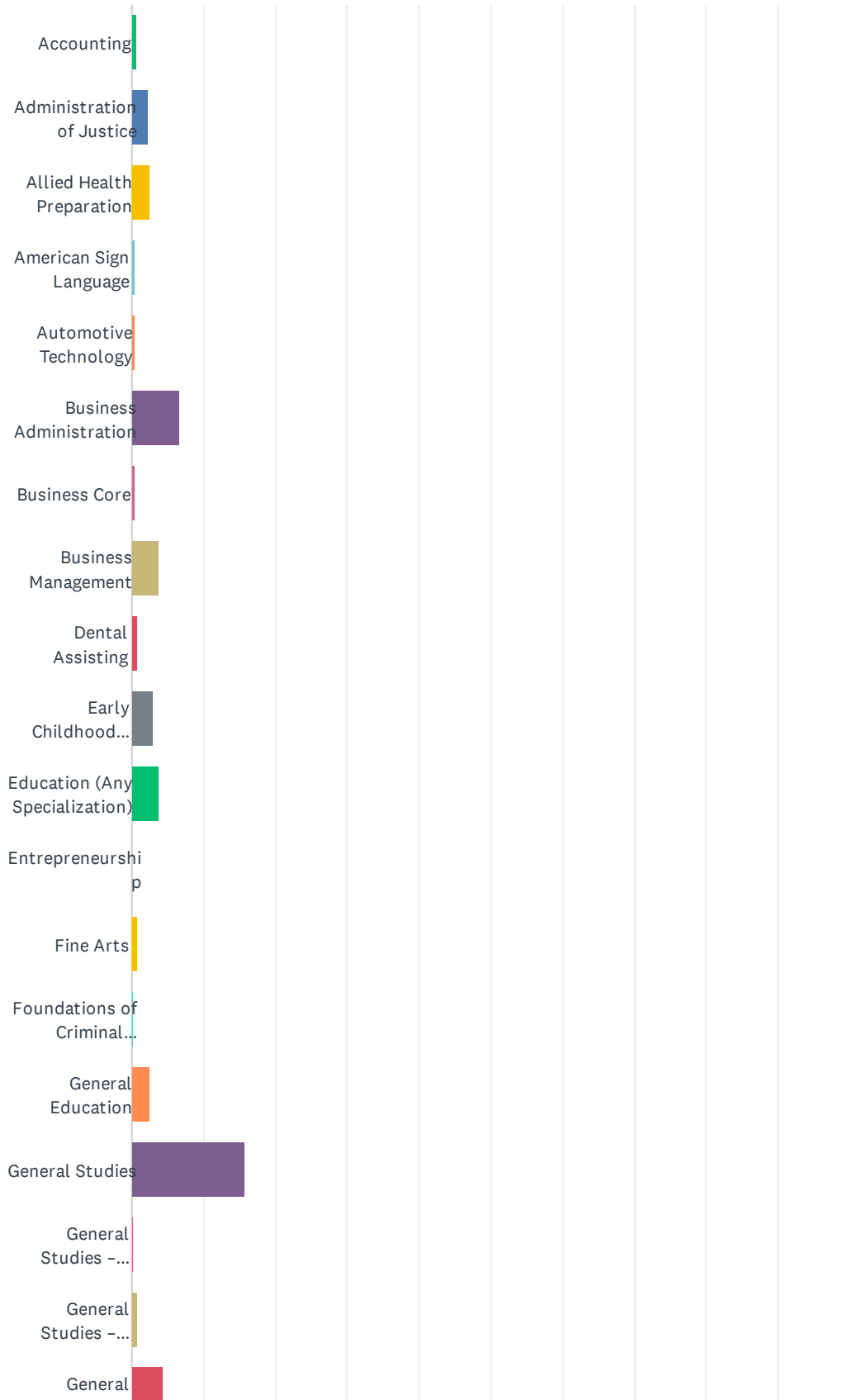

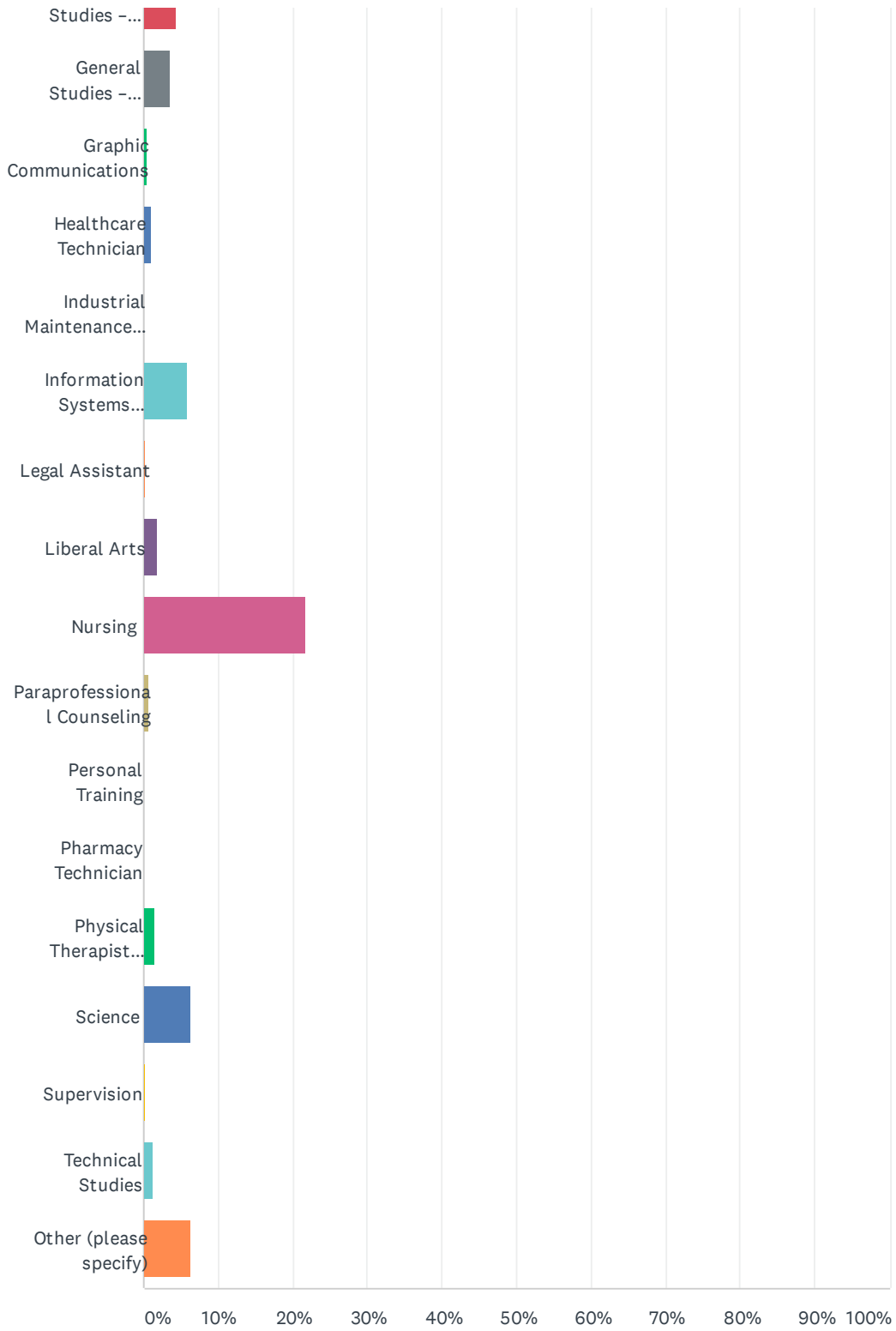

Q10 How many semesters have you attended Germanna (including Fall 2021)?

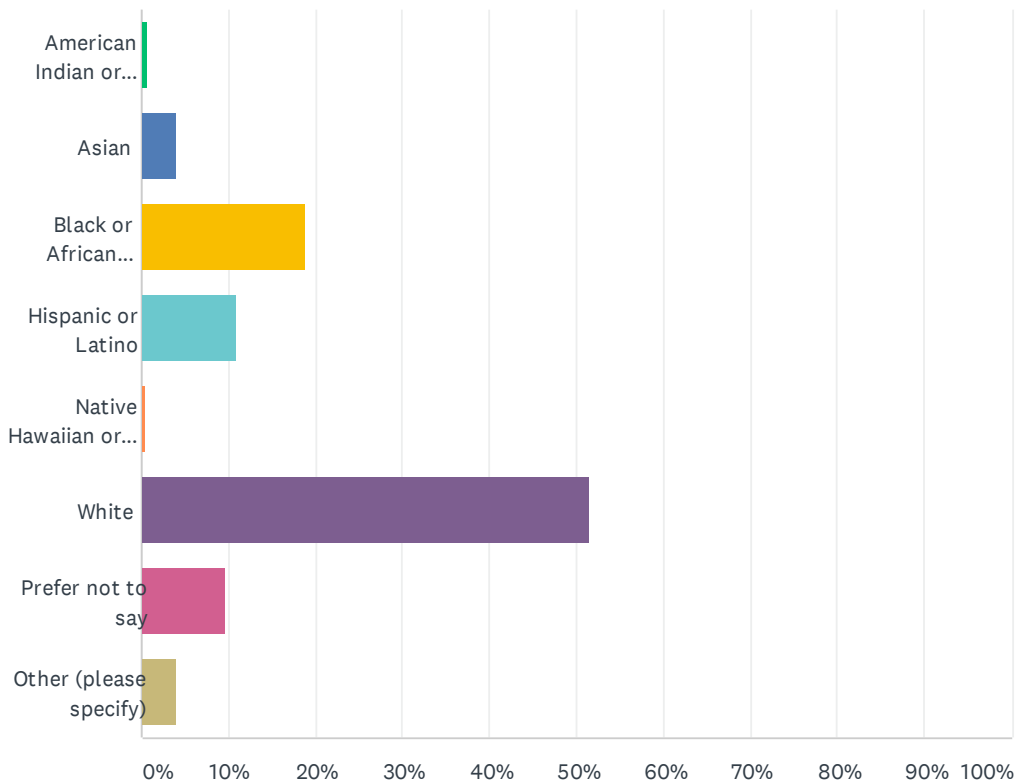

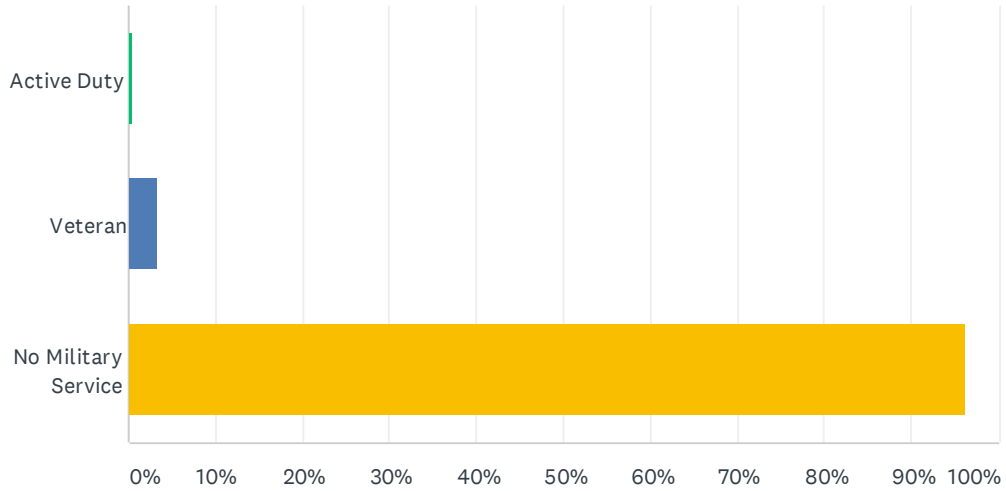

Q12 What is your military status?

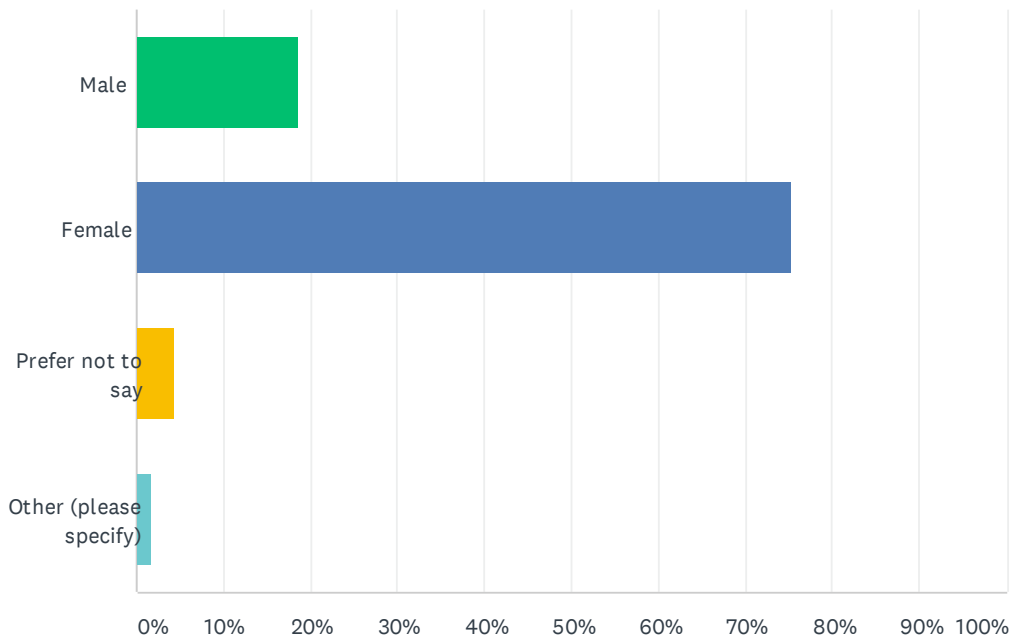

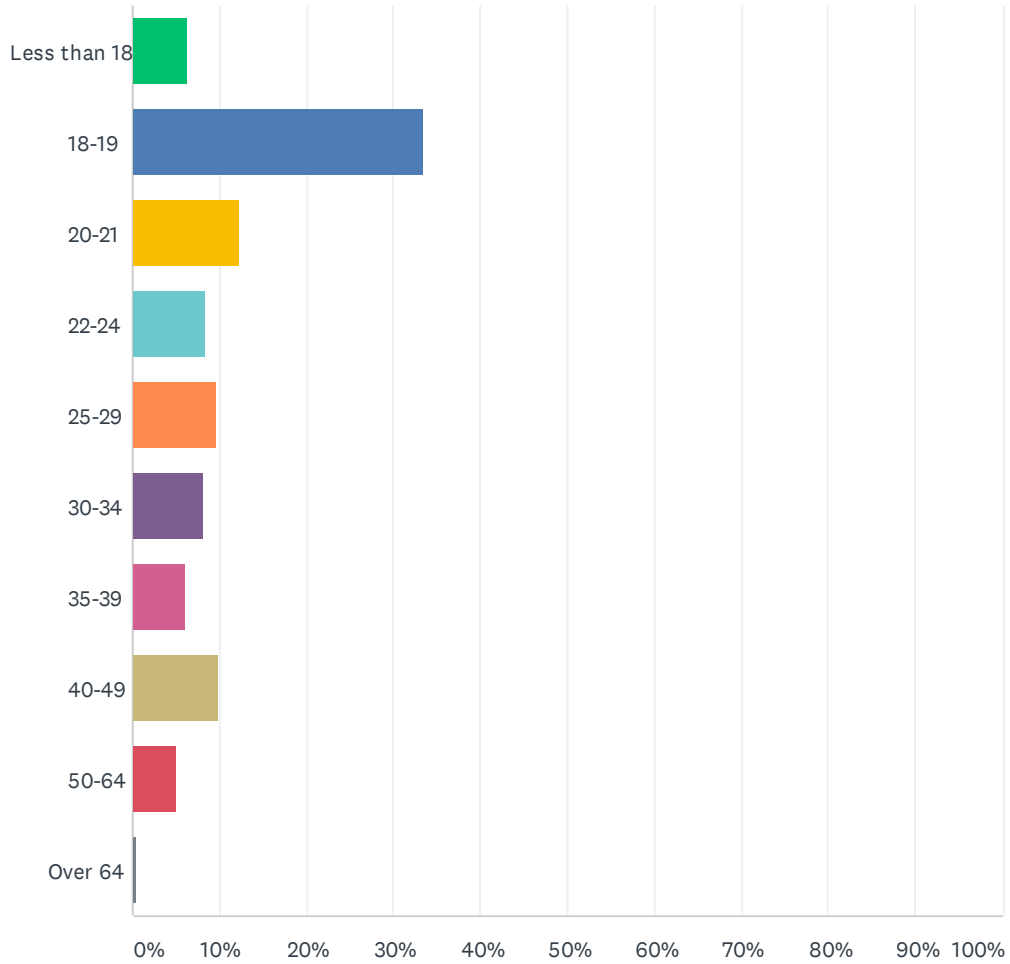
